School Uniform Enforcement Policy

PURPOSE

To outline expectations around uniform enforcement.

SCOPE

This policy applies to all members of the Portland Secondary College Community.

POLICY

School uniform is the responsibility of the <u>Level Leaders</u> (LL) who, in collaboration with their Mentors, ensure:

- systematic enforcement
- systematic monitoring
- maintenance of written records
- punitive consequences if necessary

Portland Secondary College has a ban on <u>ALL</u> hoodies and jackets (such as Katmandu) and any other brands that are NOT part of the school uniform and/or displaying the PSC logo.

General staff support is to be in the following form:

In class, insist on non-regulation jackets and caps being taken off (not confiscated) before the lesson starts. Get on with the lesson.

Sometime after the lesson, at your convenience, inform the LL or Mentor in <u>writing</u> of uniform non-compliance.

Around the grounds, maintain a friendly disposition but challenge and encourage uniform compliance.

At your convenience, inform the LL or Mentor in writing of uniform non-compliance.

If comfortable doing so, please take the offending uniform item and hand it to the relevant LL. RELATED POLICIES AND RESOURCES
