

CLASSROOM SEATING GUIDELINE

PURPOSE

In order to maximise student learning, teachers have the right to seat students where they wish.

SCOPE

This guideline applies to all members of the Portland Secondary College Community.

GUIDELINE

In order to support cooperative learning as an important facet of our teaching and learning policy, staff are required to ensure that classrooms have tables / chairs left in the accepted table group structure where it applies.

Staff are able to vary the table / seating arrangements to allow for other T / L approaches (individual, conferencing etc.) for particular lessons but should return furniture to the agreed group setting at the end of class.

Teachers have the right to direct where students are to be seated and not be challenged by students in doing so.
